

Over next 5 years, 1.8 Billion EUR will be invested into maintenance and augmentation projects (<u>Source</u>)

Summary of market opportunities in the public sector

- Enormous investment needs in the area of public water supply and wastewater disposal
- Challenges: Corruption, BBBEE (<u>Article</u>), Financial constraints
- Opportunities for new infrastructure, maintenance and increased efficiency (keyword energy efficiency).
- The market opportunities depend on the region (country/province/municipality) due to the available financial resources, as well as the existing skills and capacities for the implementation of projects.
- Municipalities and large water suppliers are ready to engage with innovative technologies.
- Significant changes to the institutional framework have recently been initiated (National Water Resource Infrastructure Agency) - Expected increase in water supply projects of million. EUR 500 to EUR 1.5 billion per year by developing commercial financing options.








Drivers of industrial water use and wastewater management

- South Africa is a pioneer in the application of environmental technologies in Africa and demand is increasing in other southern African countries.
- Strengthening environmental awareness in society and in companies
- Laws and regulations that favor the implementation of measures
- Economic efficiency as a pull factor: Rising costs for energy, water and waste treatment are making measures increasingly economically attractive
- The risk of water shortages and public infrastructure failure affecting industrial production is increasing
- The importance of operator models (e.g. BOOT) is increasing
