The A, B, and C categories of the dual vocational education and training interventions have been created by the DIHK to describe the contents and structures of the courses and programmes, making it possible to execute the German model outside Germany.

- *German dual vocation qualifications implemented outside Germany (Category A)*
- *Local dual vocational training following the German model (Category B)*
- *Local dual qualification with elements of the German system (Category C)*

C-Accreditation of suitable training courses and or programmes

This service enables our members and partners to apply for accreditation of training courses, a process conducted by the AHK in accordance with a set procedure.

Criteria for the AHK Accreditation

- 1 The training has a minimum duration of 240 hours.
- 2 Availability of high-quality training material and other training resources.
- 3 A properly structured combination of theory, practical and or on-the-job components.
- 4 Record of classroom and on-the-job training activities.
- 5 Training provided by experienced teachers, mentors and experts.
- 6 Structured assessment tools for theory and on-the-job components.
- 7 Trainers to possess the AdA International Vocational Trainer course.
- 8 Supporting youth in accessing job opportunities and starting small businesses.

- Incorporate the elements of the German VET methods in the delivery and assessment processes.

- C-Accreditation Certificate valid for three years.
